* The new year started from the 12th century up to 1751 on **March 25th**. Therefore March was the first month of the year. Therefore **September** was the seventh month, **October** the eighth, **November** the ninth and **December** the tenth month of the year. After 1751 the start of the year was changed to January 1st but the old names of the months were not changed. Therefore September became the 9th month, October the 10th month, November the 11th month and December the 12th month.
